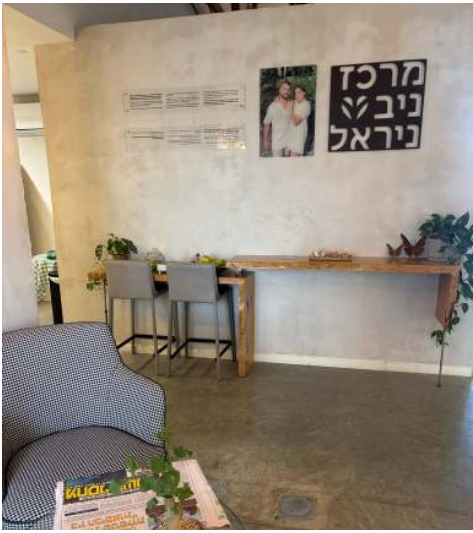
## SPECIAL SHABBAT EXPERIENCES: CONNECTION, GROWTH, AND EMPOWERMENT

## HADASSAH NEURIM TAKES PART IN AN INTERNATIONAL PROJECT FOR CHILDREN'S RIGHTS

Hadassah Neurim Youth Village was selected to participate in a groundbreaking international project alongside six other schools across Israel. The initiative aims to create a significant change in children's rights awareness in the country.

Seven students from grades 9-11 are taking part in the project, which revolves around the concept of "In Our Hands"—a student-managed support space within the school.



The goal is to eliminate uncertainty during the enlistment process, ensuring that students meet their commanders before the draft and know exactly where they will serve and under what conditions. We look forward to seeing the positive impact of this program on our graduates soon!

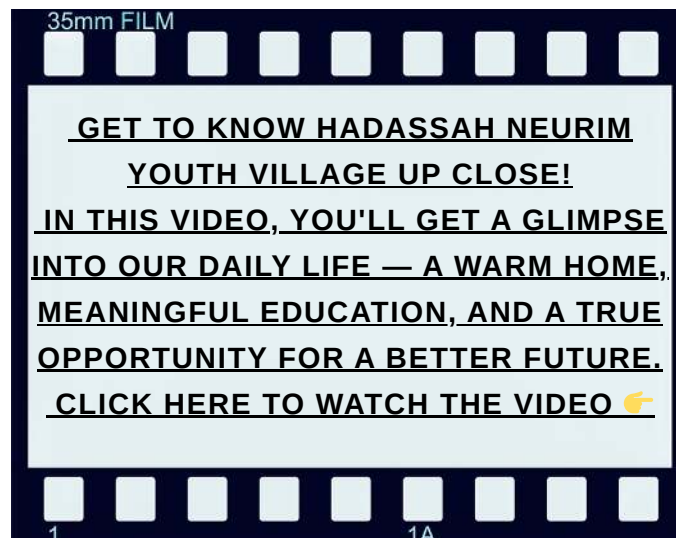

# HADASSAH NEURIM LAUNCHES A DOG FOSTER PROGRAM

A new and exciting initiative has begun at the village in collaboration with the Manmon Foundation—a dog foster program within the dormitories.

This unique project allows dormitory students to provide temporary foster homes for abandoned dogs, serving as an alternative to shelters or holding facilities. During this period, students take full responsibility for the dogs' needs and work on their rehabilitation and behavioral training, preparing them for adoption into loving permanent homes.
